Chest pain: Diagnosis and Management

Chest pain is a common symptom of patients presenting to clinics. Not all chest pain are of cardiac origin. A careful clinic history and examination can help in ruling out cardiac chest pain. ECG can further improve diagnosis of chest pain of cardiac origin, especially acute coronary syndrome.

Various causes and clinical presentation of acute and chronic chest pain will be discussed as well as associated ECG changes and their management.
