

DO YOU HAVE TYPE 2 DIABETES?

Cardiovascular events (heart disease and stroke) are the leading cause of death among patients with diabetes. The **ADOPT (Asian Diabetes Outcomes Prevention Trial)** aims to identify patients with diabetes and high risk of developing heart disease and stroke, for preventive therapy to reduce the risk of these events.

You are a potential participant for this study if you:



are ≥ 40 years of age



have had Type 2 diabetes for at least six months



have no known cardiovascular events (heart disease and stroke)

The study duration is approximately four years, including a screening visit, interim visits and up to three outpatient visits. All medications prescribed for the active preventive therapy are medications that are widely used in patients with diabetes mellitus.
