What is the purpose of the study?

Hypertension is a silent killer.

It claims 9.4 million annual deaths worldwide.

1 in 4 adults in Singapore has hypertension and 50% of the patients do not take medication.

- An additional study device to be worn for 8 hours on the same day
- Complete a questionnaire (5-10 minutes) at each visit
